Pastor Harka has been continuing in ministry for 3 months

- Communication with Pastor Harka continues to be difficult and intermittent. The electrical shortage, time difference, and communication continue to be a challenge in our correspondence with him.
- Most of the congregation has now recovered from the sickness which made the rounds from family to family. One elderly man’s condition is worsened by asthma, and he requires oxygen around the clock.
- They have had opportunity to share the radios proclaiming the gospel in Nepali to workers.

- Pastor Harka finished translating Final Destiny by William MacDonald into Nepali, and is handing out copies as part of his pastor training. We have a resource in Nepal to distribute other books by William MacDonald, and are pursuing those avenues as well.
- Six new families attended the services to worship the Lord in May. Pray for their growth!
- Pastor Harka has been running a pastor’s training center. He hopes to have about 10 regular students, but we are trusting God to provide the funding.

Praise Reports

- The Pastor Harka, his family and lay pastors have recovered from the sickness going around. There was a request for a boy named Joe who is sick.
- The children received toothbrushes, clothes and vitamins, and are "thankful to their friends in USA."
- The pastors receiving the bicycles were thankful. One pastor said "I can go long distance to serve God. It is easier."

- The Nepali government is once again in chaos. Pastor Harka requests prayer for his country, specifically that the new government installed would be a “good government.”
